And holy is his Name.*

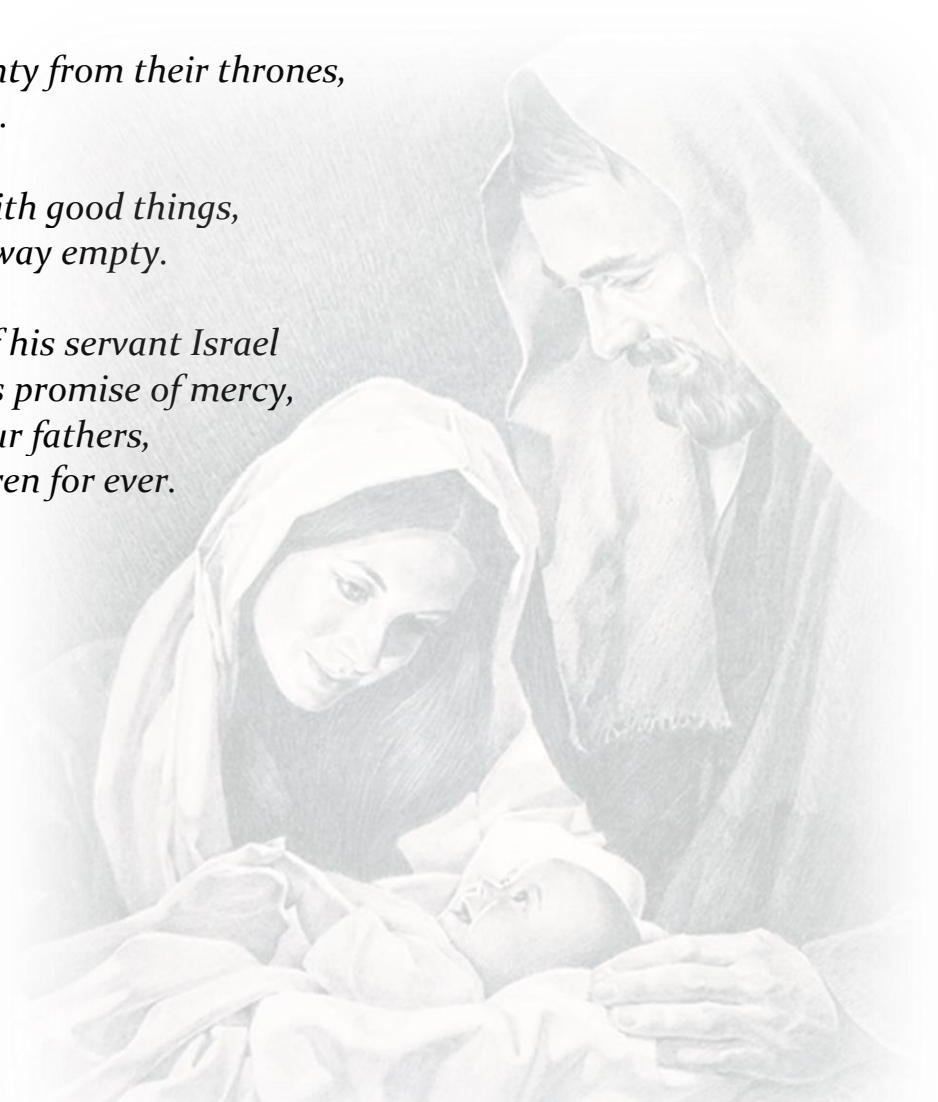
*He has mercy on those who fear him
