Q. What is the CWV?

A. The Catholic War Veterans is a non-profit Veterans organization dedicated to nourishing returning veterans in their love of country and their Catholic faith. We are dedicated to a program of united action to promote the well-being of all veterans, joining forces with other veteran service organizations whenever and wherever possible, to influence public opinion, promote good laws, and to improve the lot of the veteran.

Q. What can I do to help accomplish these goals?

A. Being a veteran, you have a special awareness of the obligation and need to defend your country. As a Catholic, you recognize that in addition to the very real physical and political threats to the welfare of our great nation, there are moral and spiritual threats as well.
