Steps to Receiving Reconciliation Celebrating Reconciliation

1. Greet the priest when he welcomes you.

- 2. Pray the Sign of the Cross, "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen."
- 3. Confess your sins to the priest.
- 4. When you have finished, say, "Please forgive me for all of my sins and any others I cannot remember."
- 5. The priest will give you your penance. Listen to what he asks you to do.
- 6. Pray an Act of Contrition.

7. Receive Absolution (forgiveness) from the priest.

8. Thank the priest and leave the reconciliation room or area.

9. Do your penance.

10. Go in peace knowing that God loves you and forgives you and your sins.
