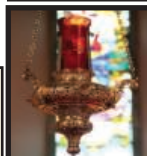

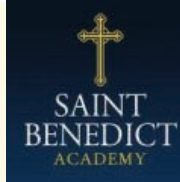

The Essence of Benedictine Spirituality

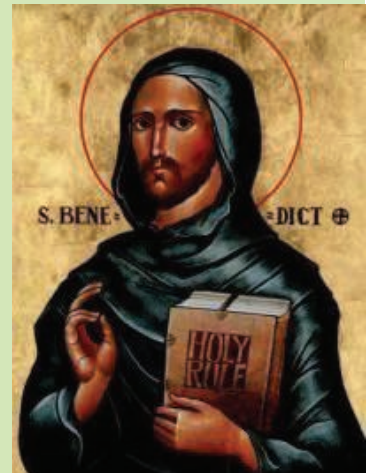
The Benedictine goal is to seek God. Benedictine life is fueled by Scripture and prayer and an effort to see and find God in each person and experience in daily life.

Every person is to be treated as Christ and all material things are to be treated with respect and care. Life is to be lived in moderation with a healthy balance between work and prayer. Benedictines are to listen in love in obedience to the will of God as they have perceived it in prayer, *lectio*, and *life events*.

They live the Rule and the Christian life in community with other God-committed individuals and continue their efforts at conversion of heart. Fidelity in faith and stability of heart and place are also key aspects of Benedictine life.

Benedictine spirituality advises and points the way to living the Christian life to its fullest extent by deepening the person's relationship to God and developing a personal relationship/friendship with Jesus Christ. The Benedictine tries to live in the present in prayerful and loving connection to God and family, as well as to his or her religious and civic community.
