<u>Children's Liturgy of the Word:</u> All children Preschool (ages 4 & 5) through Grade 5 celebrate the Liturgy of the Word during the 9:30 am Mass. On Sunday, September 21, children will sit with you for the beginning of Mass as Father Jerome commissions the Catechists. The children will process downstairs with their Catechists and return to you at the Offertory. Beginning Sunday, September 28, please bring your children downstairs to the lower Church by 9:15am.

Children in **Grade 2** and older who have not yet received the **Sacrament of Reconciliation** (Confession) will be prepared in January and will celebrate the Sacrament during the season of Lent. Preparation for **First Eucharist** (Communion) will begin in March. A parent meeting will be held in **April** and the children will receive **First Eucharist on Sunday May 3. 2015 at the 9:30 Mass.**

<u>Middle School Youth Ministry:</u> Grades 6, 7 and 8 classes begin Monday, September 22, 2014 from 6pm-7:30pm at the Ferry St. entrance of the Parish Center.

<u>High School Youth Ministry:</u> Grades 9-10 classes begin on Tuesday, September 23, 2014 from 6:30-8:30pm.
