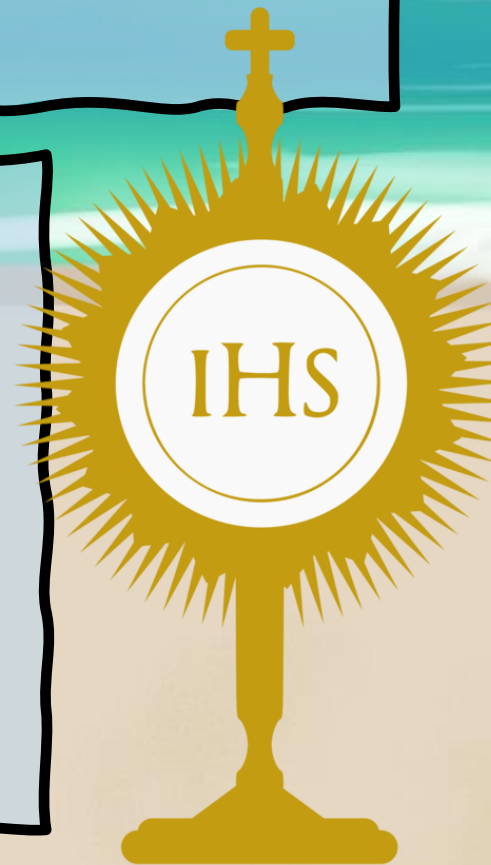

Amen.

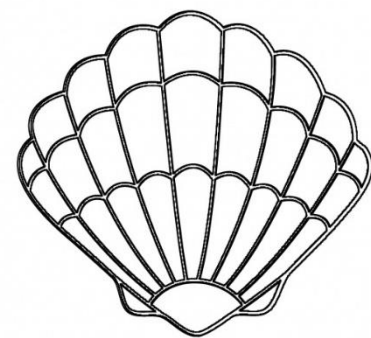
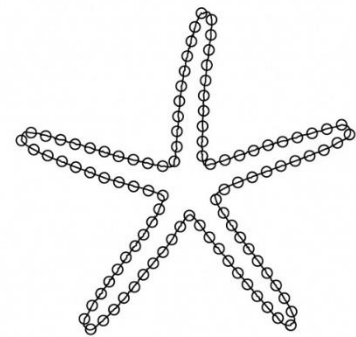
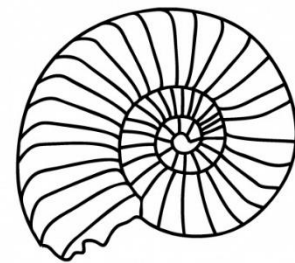
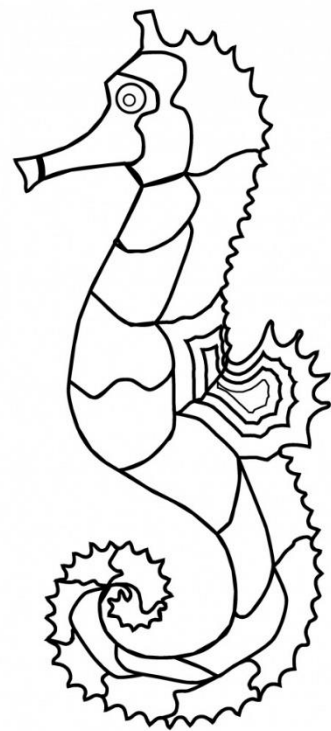
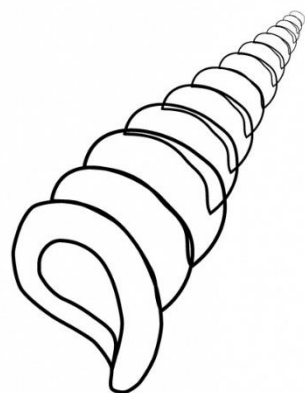
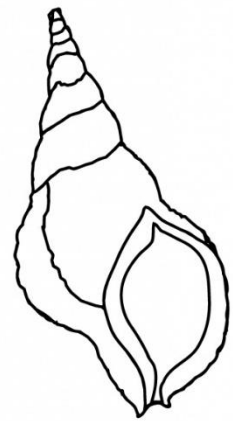
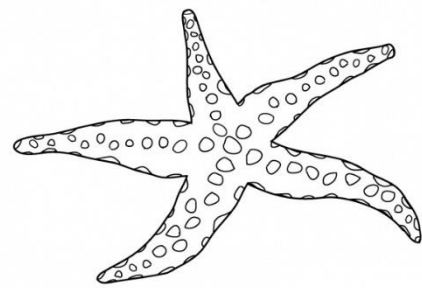
